**Meet Registration:** Registration can be found to the left hand side of the Atrium. Registration hours are:

**\*Registration fee covers 2 adults as well as their minor children. Each additional adult is charged \$25 and will need to sign the attached waiver.**

**Friday Evening:** Reconnect with your Model A friends near and far during cocktail hour with cash bar from 6:00pm - 7:00pm then enjoy dinner, the presentation "Roundtrip 1927 – 18,000 miles in a Model T Ford" by Bob Arnold followed by comedian/song writer Don White from 7:00pm -11:00pm.
